## Introduction



Required to meet the EU's "Waste Framework Directive" - national 50% recycling target by 2020



NWL's rates have plateaued between 46.3% – 46.7% for the last 5 years



Apart from Leicester City, lowest recycling rate in Leicestershire – only 1% behind Melton Borough Council and ranked 127 out of 350 local authorities










#### Composted






