Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions

The permitted hours set out above do not prohibit:

- 1. During the first twenty minutes after the above mentioned hours, the taking of the alcohol from the premises, unless the alcohol is supplied or taken in an open vessel:
- 2. The ordering of the alcohol to be consumed off the premises, or the despatch by the vendor of the alcohol so ordered;
- 3. The sale of alcohol to a trader or club for the purposes of the trade or club;
- 4. The sale or supply of alcohol to any canteen or mess, being a canteen in which the sale or supply of alcohol is carried out under the authority of the Secretary of State or an authorised mess of members of Her Majesty's naval, military or air forces.
- 5. Alcohol shall not be sold in an open container and shall not be consumed on the licensed premises.
- 6. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.
- 7. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence;
 - (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
 - (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating schedule

- 1. A CCTV multiplex system shall be installed and maintained at the premises covering the site both internally and externally, supported by 31 day recording facilities.
- 2. The checkout/point of sale shall be manned at all times by a suitably competent member of staff.
- 3. An adequate intruder alarm system shall be installed and maintained at the premises.
- Shunt locks shall be installed at the premises.
- Night pay hatch facilities shall be available at the premises.
- 6. All fire doors shall be maintained effectively self closing and shall not be held open.
- 7. The licensee will ensure that notices detailing the actions to be taken in the event of fire or other emergencies including how the fire brigade are summoned are prominently displayed and protected from damage and deterioration.
- 8. Every member of staff shall receive instruction and training as appropriate to their position in respect of health and safety at work and age related product sales.
- 9. An adequate number of waste receptacles for use by patrons shall be provided and the premises cleaned daily.
- 10. All age related products shall only be supplied through supervised sale.
- 11. The licensee shall operate and maintain a policy requiring the production of proof of age for any sale that takes place where there is any suspicion that the customer is under 21 years of age.
- 12. Details of all refused sales shall be recorded in a book maintained for that purpose and stored at the point of sale.





Ref: Total Garage 250 Bardon Road Coalville, We understand that the service station has put in an application for 24hrs license, as the next door neighbors we are writing to you in hope to ask you not to grant this application.

When the license was first applied for we did appose it through the planning department not yourselves as we did not know this was what we should have done.

As you may not be aware the service station has had to close the shop at night because of incidents that have happened, the police I am sure will be aware of these incident and should be documented.

We are sure you will understand that encouraging people to buy alcohol 24 hrs a day will only increase anti social behavior and under age drinking.

The amount of beer cans, bottles ,etc will only increase and the disturbance to the service stations neighbors, with their customers using the station as an out side toilet urinating round the side of the garage among other things.

We know other residents do not wish this license to be granted and we are sure they will be writing to you themselves.

Please listen to what the residents say as we have to live with the rubbish that the garage customers leave behind, we do have an off license and a pub and a super market selling liquor, we do not see the need for a garage to encourage drink driving.
