1.0 Background

- 1.1 The District Council has power under Section 65 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976 to set fares for hackney carriages.
- 1.2 This report is presented after representations were made by the trade at the Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Drivers' Consultative Forum.
- 1.3 At this meeting the trade were in agreement that there should be an increase in the fare table. An increase in 10p from £3.40 to £3.50 up to and including the first mile was requested to be put to the Licensing Committee for approval.
- 1.4 If the Committee approves the recommendation, officers will need to publish the proposed variations in a local newspaper, giving at least 14 days for objection. If no objections are received, then the new fares will take effect on a date specified in the notice. However, the local authority must consider any objections received and can either revise the fare table in

- the light of those objections or the fare table as originally proposed will come into effect on a new date, within 2 months of the original date.
- 1.5 The last increase in the hackney carriage fare table took place in July 2008 when the cheapest price for a litre of diesel, locally, was 127.9p. Since that date the price of a litre of fuel did fall to less than £1 but has since risen due to the cost of crude oil and various tax rises. The cost of a litre of diesel is currently (24/1/2011) 131.9p and expected to rise further in the short term. A barrel of Brent crude oil on 24th January 2011 was \$97.93.
- 1.6 The Council's current hackney carriage fare table is attached as Appendix A.
- 1.7 There is also concern amongst the trade that the Council will not be able to react quickly enough when further sharp increases in fuel prices occur. With the time between Committee meetings running into several months drivers are concerned that they would have to endure erosion to their earnings before members could agree to start the fare increase procedure. Further fuel increases are predicted over the next few months and the trade would be appreciative if members could resolve to agree a mechanism for implementing a further fare increase.
- 1.8 It is recommended that members also agree to a further fare increase with its implementation being deferred until the price of a litre of diesel reaches 136.9p and remains at that level for 14 days. This price will be based on the displayed price at Morrisons Supermarket on Whitwick Road, Coalville.
- 1.9 If the above requirements are met the fare increase will be from £3.50 to £3.60 for the first mile travelled. It must be borne in mind that the usual advertisement of the increase and 28 days consultation period will still apply.
- 1.10 It is recommended that in order to respond quickly to increases in fuel prices that the matter of approving a variation of the hackney carriage fare table be delegated to the Director of Services in consultation with the Portfolio Holder.
- 1.11 It is proposed to draft a table of fares linked to fuel prices. The trade will be consulted at the driver consultative forum in March 2011. Once agreed by the trade, the table will be used as a basis on which future variations of the fare table will be made.
