The plan which accompanies this application indicates the proposed position for the display and storage of alcohol. The alcohol may be displayed or stored, from time to time, in different positions within the store.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

- A CCTV system will be maintained which is fit for the purpose. The system will incorporate
 a camera covering the entrance door and be capable of providing an image which is
 regarded as identification standard.
- The CCTV system will incorporate a recording facility and any recording will be retained
 and stored in a suitable and secure manner for a minimum of one calendar month. A
 system will be in place to maintain the quality of the recorded image and a complete audit
 trail maintained.
- The CCTV system will be maintained and fully operational throughout the hours that the premises are open for any licensable activity.
- 4. The precise position of the cameras may be agreed with police from time to time.

c) Public safety

The applicant will at all times maintain adequate levels of staff. Such staff levels will be disclosed, on request, to the licensing authority and police.

d) The prevention of public nuisance


Adequate waste receptacles for use by customers shall be provided in and immediately outside the premises.

Signage will be displayed at the exit of the premises requesting customers leaving the premises late at night to do so quietly and with consideration so as not to disturb nearby residents.

e) The protection of children from harm

All staff will be trained to request evidence of age from any person seeking to buy alcohol and appearing to the member of staff to be under the age of 18. Such evidence is to be of a photographic nature such as a passport or photographic driving licence until other effective identification technology, such as thumbprint or pupil recognition, is introduced.

I am writing in relation to the recent licensing application at the Jet Petrol Station (Coalville Service Station, 30 London Road). I feel the result of the proposal will have a devastating affect on the local community. It is these types of outlets that may serve members of the community that are disobedient; resulting in added crime, public nuisance and disorderly behaviour.

The area has constantly been affected by theft, vandalism and disorderly behaviour and I presume that this will greatly increase and develop should an alcohol licence be granted on the site.

Access to the petrol station is hazardous to pedestrians and motorists as it stands with the fuel on the site; I would only presume that large quantities of alcohol on site would surely be a greater health and safety risk to the predominately residential dwellings in the area. Should traffic increase there may inevitably be accidents that are far more disastrous. The disruption of noise and litter would also be a greater problem to the residents in the area at present.

Overall, I believe that this site should not be given an alcohol licence as there are already far too many premises that offer the facility at present and there would surely be added health and safety risks for the site.

In accordance to the procedures set out in the towns planning policy, I have expressed my views on the proposed alcohol-licensing scheme for the Jet Petrol Station (Coalville Service Station, 30 London Road). I am opposed to the scheme for many reasons, of which a few are set out below.

The proposed licence would adversely affect the amenities of occupiers of dwellings/premises in the vicinity by reasons of nearness, late evening noise and disturbance. There would be inadequate parking provision for visitors to the premises, resulting in additional noise and disturbance from vehicles parking in the near vicinity of residential properties and would cause interference with the safety and free-flow of traffic in the adjoining highways through increased demand for on street parking. The proposal would therefore conflict with policy 8.6 and 8.7 of the Leicestershire Unitary Development Plan (2005) and The Development Control Guidelines for the development of dwellings adopted by the Local Planning Authority as Supplementary Planning Guidance.

In relation to other problems like public nuisance, crime and disorderly behaviour, these will affect the adjoining neighbourhoods of a residential area. The site is located away from the high street and is predominately in a residential area.

It must also be brought to the council's attention that owners of various other sites in the near vicinity have an alcohol licence and their trade will significantly be affected. There seems to be no need for a licence as a fuelling station should stay as a fuelling station and not a superstore.

The reasons for this being, I live opposite the petrol station and I cannot have my window open at night due to deliveries very early in the morning, if this site was open 24 hours as a resident I feel that I would not have any peace because of 24 hour activity.

I also oppose the selling of alcohol as I feel this is a busy road as it is with people walking from the pubs in town and many people singing and shouting and making a general nusience, I think that to be able to then buy alcohol from the petrol station would only make things worse. I already get rubbish thrown into my front garden as it is (beer cans and bottles), I think that this would be worse.

There is also a childrens home in the vicinity and if this was open past the usual 11.00PM it could be a temptation to sit on the wall outside the petrol station.

This licence would cause major disruption to all residents.
