I refer to the Sub-Committee hearing of 5th April 2007 whereby the above application was determined having regard to representations made.

I write to confirm the decision of the Sub-Committee to refuse the grant of the premises licence. In reaching its decision the Sub-committee has had regard to the evidence and representations of the applicant and interested parties/responsible authorities, the Council's Statement of Licensing Policy and Guidance issued under Section 182 of the Licensing Act 2003.

The Sub-Committee considered that:

- (1) To allow the premises to operate during the hours requested would be likely to result in incidents of crime and disorder in and around the premises.
- (2) To allow the premises to operate during the hours requested would be likely to give rise to public nuisance.
- (3) The measures proposed by the applicant were not sufficient to prevent the licensing objectives being undermined.
- (4) There were no modifications which could be made to the application or conditions imposed which would prevent the licensing objectives being undermined.

Therefore, having considered all these factors the Sub-Committee has decided to refuse the application.

An appeal against this decision may be made to the Magistrates' Court for the pathy session area in which the premises concerned are although within 21 days from the date of receipt of the notification of the decision.

The following views are made on behalf of over 100 members of the Ashby de la Zouch Civic Society. As you are aware there is an ongoing problem of late night crime and disorder, public nuisance and violence in Ashby de la Zouch town Centre.

This has been contained by the imposition of a special saturation policy for the Town Centre. We wholeheartedly support this policy which would normally refuse all new licences.

We would conclude on the information available that there is no justification, especially in light of the saturation policy to allow this licence application.

The authority seeks to achieve a balance between leisure and entertainment and the needs of local residents. The key licensing objective of late night refreshment is the prevention of crime, disorder and public nuisance.

A late night licence extension for these premises will encourage disorder and anti-social behaviour by concentrating crowds of young people exiting different local public houses in and around the premises. Experience of Ashby shows that, when young people having consumed alcohol in different pubs, meet in the street, there occurs threatening behaviour, violence and damage to property. These premises would be a focus for these people.

There are several residential, over shop flats and residential houses in this area who would be subject to disturbance and the trading hours allowed should reflect this. The impact on residents in the vicinity of a late licence and people congregating around this street stall premises would be disproportionate and unreasonable.

The cumulative effects of litter will cause a public nuisance. Spilt and discarded food by drunken customers would be a health and slippage hazard to pedestrians.

We are of a mind to understand the public benefit of such an establishment in offering a "chill out" facility and service to late night visitors to the town centre. However on balance we feel that an extension until 1.00am during the week and 3.00pm at weekends would cause unreasonable public nuisance and encourage crime and disorder.

We would remind the Authority that a recent application by Subway was restricted to a 1.00am closure and imposed street clean-up requirements.

We therefore request that this late licence application is refused.



ASHBY KEBAB MOBILE FOOD OUTLET

I understand that an application has been received by you to have a vehicle placed at the end of Union Passage on Market Street outside or near to Boots Chemist premises.

I do not have any details of proposed times of proposed operation. There are not notices in evidence on Boots or W. H. Smith's premises giving such details and for some past weeks I have not had a copy of The Ashby Times because they did not supply sufficient numbers of copies for sale in the paper shop outlets here.

I wish to register my objections to the granting of a licence on the following grounds.

- 1. Litter and general untidiness after the vehicle had left.
- 2. Anti-social behaviour including defecation, urination and vomiting by patrons of the mobile.
- 3. Unseemly, frightening and noisy shouting and swearing by half-sober patrons in the passage. Rattling of gates, litter in gardens. The necessity to padlock gates leading to properties and necessitating collecting of mail from the Post Office because the postman cannot enter through the locked gate.
- 4. Breaking of shop windows
 - a. Cancer Relief Shop (one occasion)
 - b. Greengrocers (two or three occasions)
 - c. Windows broken on several occasions at Christadelphian Church
 - d. Damage to fences at Christadelphian Church
- Young girls? About 12 years of age chasing round the van and seemingly being encouraged by the occupants of the vehicle shouting and screaming.
- On one occasion a replica hand gun was thrown into my garden. We did not know it was a replica until the Special Firearms Squad advised us. The miscreants of the misdemeanour were later caught and charged; I believe it was attempted robbery at the Leisure Centre.

During the period that the vehicle was allowed to be here, the above events took place. The police attended disturbances on a number of call-outs.

The police have a very difficult and dangerous job to carry out. They have limited resources which would be further diluted if spread over a larger area.

My neighbour Mrs P Prior at No 2 Union Passage holds very similar views to mine. He too is elderly, feels threatened and is pleased to support any action taken to prevent the re-appearance of problems associated with mobile catering van.

It has come to our attention and I am disappointed it is not in the public domain that a mobile take away van has applied for permission to operate on the intersection of Market Street and union passage in Ashby de la Zouch

I write to inform you of our strong objection to the proposal and we are extremely concerned regarding this proposed course of action and have the following concerns:

1. Increased Noise level

With the proposed mobile take away van location, we are extremely concerned regarding the effect this will have on noise levels. We understand that we will see once again (a mobile take away van has previously occupied this spot) a major impact on residents in the immediate vicinity. We are particularly concerned with regards to noise levels as our property is adjacent to union passage, with the bedrooms at the rear of our property

In addition we are also concerned at the increase in noise from people travelling up and down Union passage and we know from previous experience this will significantly increase in the passage way. Not only will this be a disruption to our family but to all of the residents in the close vicinity, many of which are elderly or families with young children.

2. <u>Unsociable Hours</u>

The proposed take away van attracts passers by late at night; as a result, this has the cause and effect of major disruption to our lives. On occasions, we suffer from unreasonable behaviour in Union Passage and this proposed change of use will potentially make things even worse for the residents living close by

3. Increased Litter

Due to the increased number of people using Union Passage we are concerned about the possibility of increased litter. We suffer from litter, glass and sharp objects being thrown onto our premises when there are people congregating around Union Passage. Any additional litter being thrown onto our premises will increase the likelihood of our children being injured or picking up injuries from sharp objects.

4. Unsociable behaviour

Based upon previous experience, once again, due to the increased number of people using Union Passage we are concerned about the behaviour of individuals, as previously we have seen excessive vomiting and urinating from a take away van positioned in this location. As Ashby is trying to widen its appeal and attract new people into the town, we feel this will have the opposite affect

Based on all of the above points, we find the proposed take away van location and idea to be wholly unacceptable and are strongly opposed to any licensing being granted. We are especially concerned that all of the above points raised will have a major effect on the quality of life our family has in Ashby De La Zouch.

Finally. I am sure you will agree there are more than enough fast food and take away facilities in the town now as there have been recent additions in Market Street and I fail to see why we need anymore, surely the local residents must be taken into account and their views must be taken into consideration

Should you need any clarification on any of the above points we would be willing to discuss these further with you at any time and we would be willing to attend any hearing that would be heard.
