| Purpose of report | To determine an application to vary a premises licence to specify an individual as designated premises supervisor at Kris Store located at 54-56 High Street Ibstock, Coalville, Leicestershire, LE67 6LH. This report outlines the application and summarises the representations received. ## 1. Background

1.1 The premises currently operate as a convenience store and have the benefit of a premises licence. The premises licence authorises the sale of alcohol for consumption off the premises. A copy of the premises licence is attached as appendix 1.
1.2 A map showing the location of the premises is attached as appendix 2.
1.3 On $10^{\text {th }}$ December 2009 an application to vary the premises licence to specify Mrs Lilubai Modhvadia as the designated premises supervisor at Kris Stores was received from Mrs Lilubai Modhvadia. A copy of the application is attached as appendix 3.
1.4 The applicant has applied for the outcome of this application to take immediate effect in accordance with Section 38 of the Licensing Act 2003.

### 2.0 Representations

2.1 The applicant is required to serve a copy of their application on Leicestershire Constabulary.
2.2 The Responsible Authority is able to make representations within 14 days of the notice of application to the Licensing Authority.
2.3 Where a Chief Officer of Police is satisfied that the exceptional circumstances of a case are such that granting the application would undermine the crime prevention objective, he must give the licensing authority a notice stating the reasons he is so satisfied.
2.4 The police gave such notice on $23^{\text {rd }}$ December 2009 and stated in it that because Mrs Modhvadia has been charged with a relevant offence, namely 3 counts of supplying goods to which false trade description applied, contrary to the Trade Descriptions Act 1968 s1(1)(b) at Corby Magistrates Court on $25^{\text {th }}$ March 2009.
2.5 Leicestershire Constabulary's letter of objection is attached as appendix 4.

## 3 Statutory Guidance

3.1 In making its decision, the Sub-Committee is obliged to have regard to Guidance issued by the Secretary of State under Section 182 of the Licensing Act 2003. All Licensing Committee members have been provided with a full copy of the guidance document. Officers consider that paragraphs 1.28 to $1.30,2.1$ to $2.18,4.19$ to $4.27,4.28$ to $4.30,4.32$ to $4.34,10.45$ to 10.47 and 12.1 to 12.10 may have a bearing upon the application.

### 4.0 Statement of Licensing Policy

4.1 The Sub-Committee is also obliged to have regard to its own Statement of Licensing Policy. Officers consider that paragraphs $7.1,12.2$ to $12.3,15.1$ to $15.3,17.1$ to 17.3 may have a bearing upon the application.

### 5.0 Observations

5.1 The Committee is obliged to determine this application with a view to promoting the prevention of crime and disorder.
5.2 The Committee may take one of the following steps, if any, as it considers necessary for the promotion of the licensing objectives:
a) Approve the application to vary the designated premises supervisor.
b) Remove the designated premises supervisor.
5.3 There is a right of appeal to the Magistrates Court against the decision of the SubCommittee by the applicant, premises licence holder and persons who made relevant representations within 21 days of receiving the notice.

## Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions

The permitted hours set out above do not prohibit:

1. During the first twenty minutes after the above mentioned hours, the taking of the alcohol from the premises, unless the alcohol is supplied or taken in an open vessel;
2. The ordering of the alcohol to be consumed off the premises, or the despatch by the vendor of the alcohol so ordered;
3. The sale of alcohol to a trader or club for the purposes of the trade or club;
4. The sale or supply of alcohol to any canteen or mess, being a canteen in which the sale or supply of alcohol is carried out under the authority of the Secretary of State or an authorised mess of members of Her Majesty's naval, military or air forces.
5. Alcohol shall not be sold in an open container and shall not be consumed on the licensed premises.
6. Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.
7. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence;
(a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
(b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
