Annex 1 - Mandatory conditions

- 1. No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence;
 - a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
 - b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.
- 2. Every supply of alcohol must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

Mandatory conditions coming into force from 6th April 2010:

- (1) The responsible person shall take all reasonable steps to ensure that staff on relevant premises do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises.
 - (2) In this paragraph, an irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises in a manner which carries a significant risk of leading or contributing to crime and disorder, prejudice to public safety, public nuisance, or harm to children—
 - (a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to—
 - (i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or
 - (ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);
 - (b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic (other than any promotion or discount available to an individual in respect of alcohol for consumption at a table meal, as defined in section 159 of the Act);
 - (c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less;
 - (d) provision of free or discounted alcohol in relation to the viewing on the premises of a sporting event, where that provision is dependent on—
 - (i) the outcome of a race, competition or other event or process, or
 - (ii) the likelihood of anything occurring or not occurring;
 - (e) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner.
- 2. The responsible person shall ensure that no alcohol is dispensed directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of a disability).
- 3. The responsible person shall ensure that free tap water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.

Mandatory conditions coming into force from 1st October 2010:


- (1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.
 - (2) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.
- 2. The responsible person shall ensure that
 - (a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures
 - (i) beer or cider: ½ pint;
 - (ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and
 - (iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml; and
 - (b) customers are made aware of the availability of these measures.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating schedule

- 1. Prominent, clear notices shall be displayed requesting customers to respect the needs of local residents and leave the premises and the area quietly.
- 2. The licensee shall introduce a policy requiring the production of "proof of age" for any sale that takes place where there is any suspicion that the customer is under 18. Such proof may include a pass conforming to the PASS accreditation system, photo driving licence, student cards and passports.
- 3. The licensee will not introduce or carry on any irresponsible sales promotion or discounting of prices of alcoholic beverages.
- 4. CCTV shall be installed and maintained at the premises in accordance with the information commissioners CCTV code of practice.

Annex 3 – Conditions attached after a hearing by the licensing authority

- 1. No bottles or glasses shall be removed from the premises and permitted onto Market Street, North Street, or any other public place.
- 2. The Premises Licence holder shall comply with the Dispersal Policy for the premises (see document attached) as agreed by Members at the Licensing Sub-Committee hearing held on 27th February 2012.
- 3. The Dispersal Policy shall be made available to interested parties within 7 days upon written request. The Dispersal Policy may be amended from time to time by agreement with the Police Authority.
- 4. The total capacity of the premises shall not exceed 450, comprising 200 for the main VIP room, 100 for the Boudoir Bar, and 150 for Studio 79 located upstairs.
- 5. Noise emanating from the premises as measured at the nearest residential property shall be no more than 5dBA greater than the existing background level.
- 6. During regulated entertainment, all doors and windows shall remain closed except for access, egress and in the case of emergencies.
- 7. Suitable sound attenuation measures shall be maintained in accordance with the premises licence holders noise risk assessments and in consultation with the District Council's Environmental Health Department.
- 8. Acoustic lobbies shall be installed internally to all outside doors.
- 9. During regulated entertainment, regular noise patrols shall be conducted by staff to ensure permitted noise levels are not exceeded.
- 10. A noise limiter shall be installed in conjunction with the District Council's Environmental Health Department.
- 11. Customers using the Boudoir Bar and / or Studio 79 shall enter and exit the premises solely from Market Street except in emergencies.
- 12. The first floor outside terraced area shall be cleared of patrons at midnight.
- 13. All licensable activities shall cease at midnight in the main VIP Room on Fridays and Saturdays.





Please summarise your concerns about this application:

I write in my capacity as Licensing Officer for the Leicestershire Constabulary on the authority delegated to me by the Chief Constable Simon Cole.

Take notice that I am satisfied that allowing the premises to be used in accordance with the notice would undermine the Crime Prevention, Public Safety and Prevention of Public Nuisance objective.

North West Leicester has adopted a Special Policy in relation to applications for new licences and material variations. The effect of this policy is set out in the Council's own policy document. It creates a rebuttable presumption against the grant of any further licences.

The VIP Rooms is within the "saturation zone" identified in the Council's policy.

It is the police view that granting this application will add to the existing, late night, problems in the Town centre as the proposed late night selling of alcohol will cause revellers to drink more, drink for longer and linger in the area longer than they otherwise would.

Paragraph 13.25 in the current Guidance, issued under section 182 of the Licensing Act, states.

"In some areas, where the number, type and density of premises selling alcohol for consumption on the premises are unusual, serious problems of nuisance and disorder may be arising or have begun to arise outside or some distance from licensed premises".

These premises are centrally located in the town at the heart of the area where the night time economy continues to result in a "hot spot" for crime and disorder as described in the attached report from Sergeant 531 Watson.
