SUBJECT: Evidence of violence and assaults, for this year since Feb2012 and concerns over capacity.

You will notice that since Sgt Thornleys report, further reports are submitted for this year; from 27/2/12.

The format of these reports has changed and gives a concise picture of events since the variation was granted. The purpose of these reports is to show all incidents recorded firstly at CIROS, those in Market street and finally CCTV evidence of incidents recorded in Market Street.

I believe this paints a fuller picture of the effect of later drinking hours and direct impact of licensing hours on crime and disorder, public safety and public nuisance.

It is my contention that incidents have increased, as the premises has had later opening hours. You will clearly see that the times of the incidents are in the relevant period, of later opening hours between 2am-3am.

As a result of analysing this information it is my view that later drinking is having an adverse affect on the licensing objectives as outlined in the Licensing Act 2003.

I would draw your attention to the spreadsheet Incidents in Ashby

This report has been filtered to show relevant crime reports in Market street Ashby. These are crimes reported to Police, from Midnight until early hours only.

There have been 27 crimes reported since March 2012. Of these crimes 13 are directly attributable to CIROS premises nearly 50%.

In addition there are further incidents that have occurred in the street, following the closing of the club when other premises are closed.

You will see from the pattern the following number of incidents

- 3 in March
- 6 in April
- 3 in May
- 3 in June
- 9 in July

You will also note the times of the incidents. 13 have occurred from around 2am until 03.30am again nearly 50% of all incidents.

I can confirm that the only other night club in the area, did not have extensions to their license on the dates on the report, where incidents have occurred in the Market street.

My conclusion is that current later opening hours, are adversely affecting the licensing objectives. By definition I would say any TEN over the current hours, would further negatively impact on the licensing objectives.

I would draw your attention to Incidents in CIROS

There have been 13 crimes at CIROS. Of these crimes there have been 10 assaults. Of these assaults there have been a number of serious cases. The most high profile was an incident that occurred on Sunday 15th July between 2am and 2.30am. The victim was assaulted and received a broken jaw. The male was sentenced at Leicester Crown Court on 21st August to 14 months in prison; after pleading guilty to grievous bodily harm.

There has been several other serious assaults at the premises, all listed on the schedule.

The timings of the incidents are again relevant and you will note there are 7 crimes committed on or after 2am, one at 01.45hrs.

I would draw your attention to the case of possession of cocaine a Class A drug under the misuse drugs act. This person has admitted to being a regular at the premises.

I would draw your attention to the CCTV log

The cctv log has been developed since June this year and will show incidents in addition to those reported to the police.

Again this will show those incidents recorded at the relevant times.

In June there are 12 incidents recorded of these there are 6 on or after 2am

In July there are 24 incidents recorded of these there are 10 on or after 2am

In addition to the issue of crime and disorder and public nuisance, I would bring your attention to the capacity of the premises and issues of public safety.

A TEN will give a capacity in excess of the current limits as laid down in the premises license and so public safety will be put at risk.

Currently the premises license allows for the following limits:-

VIP 450-comprising 200 for the main VIP room 100 for the Boudoir Bar 150 for Studio 79

Queens Head and CIROS 280 total Total 730.

I would suggest that a maximum of 998 including staff, will put public safety at risk to demonstrate this, I would show you a DVD of recent events relating to the GBH on the 15th July already discussed. This DVD will show cramped premises on a normal night.

This will show door staff unable to deal with large numbers of people effectively and subsequent delay to assisting the injured party.

In conclusion I believe the above evidence clearly demonstrates the effect of later drinking and by implication, the effect of further extensions as requested in the TEN.

I am Dave Johnson and I am the CCTV Supervisor at the North West Leicestershire District Council (NWLDC) CCTV Control Room situated at 72 New Broadway, High Street Coalville, Leicestershire. I have been in post in this role for 5 years, working for various Security firms. I currently work for Premier Security Services (PSS). PSS are contracted to NWLDC for the CCTV operation; the equipment itself is owned by NWLDC. My role includes supervising the operations within the control room and I also work as an operator of the CCTV equipment which includes recording details of incidents of note in a log book.

The purpose of monitoring the cameras is to capture any incidents of note that we view or consider untoward, suspicious or criminal. Examples of this include shoplifting at Coalville town or antisocial behaviour and public order incidents in Ashby town. If we monitor an incident for at least 30seconds then I am required to make a note of the incident within a CCTV log book. This is necessary and a requirement to justify why we are viewing the incidents.

Two other CCTV operators and me have access and can use the CCTV equipment. Victoria Granger and Bruce Hood are the other two members of staff who can operate this equipment and we all enter details of incidents within the CCTV log book.

SUBJECT: Incidents at Ciro's 48 Weekends Jan 2011 - Dec 2011

Sir

The purpose of this document is to highlight the type of incidents dealt with as a direct result of licensing hours currently in force in Ashby De La Zouch. Those listed reveal a picture to the Magistrates and licensing committee of unruly behaviour that significant contributes to Crime & Disorder, Public Nuisance and against Public Safety. They range from Criminal Damage, Assaults, Theft, Indecent Exposure, & Violent Public order offences that have occurred both inside Ciro's and in Market Street.

This information does not include incidents bound by North Street, Lower Church Street, South Street, Bath Street and Derby Road. Licensed premises fronting these roads are deemed to be within the area marked as the "Cumulative Impact area" included in NWLDC licensing policy.

I selected 8 days per calendar month covering Friday & Saturday evenings only between the hours of 11pm-8am during a 12 months period. This period represents 4 weekends a month excluding Sundays.

Below are the details of incidents recorded on Leicestershire's Crime Intelligence System as opposed to those recorded on Leicestershire dispatch system. This is the system where calls are taken and recorded during these periods and may not necessarily require a crime record.

During this period there were a total of 59 reported crimes over 48 weekends and of those 23 representing a figure of 38.9 % actually occurred either inside or can be attributed directly to Ciro's club.

38.9% is a hugely significant contributory factor to Crime and Disorder, Public Nuisance and Public Safety given that this premise sites within a saturation area in Ashby.

I have also submitted further documentary evidence by way of NWLDC (CCTV Logs) that indicate a large proportion of crime and disorder is not actually being reported to the police in Market Street and a significant number of these incidents can also be directly linked to Ciro's.

This detail is contained within a further a separate report by me. (See report "CIRO's Incidents from CCTV Log & Control Room Incidents").

SUBJECT: Incidents from CCTV Log & Control Room Incidents Sgt 129 - Ciro's

As an addition to the objections I raised against the NWLDC Licensing committee's granting of extended licensing hours for Ciros nightclub on 27/2/2012 I have the following to include.

Details at the end of this report demonstrate that CCTV monitoring appears to record a significantly higher number of incidents occurring in Market Street Ashby than those actually reported to the Police.

CCTV operators are required to record in a book what they are viewing. Material footage is only retained for 30 days and is then over written. Initially when preparing this report I looked at x6 days in the December 2011 chosen because they represented temporary event notice dates by another licensed premise within the saturation zone that I was dealing with.

I did however increase the period to include all CCTV logged incidents occurring in Market Street Ashby up to the 18th March 2012 (the 18th of March was chosen as an end date simply because this was when I made my initial investigation into the feasibility of obtaining CCTV material and for no other reason). I only included incidents recorded in Market Street. The six days initially used were the 9th, 16th and 23rd of December representing Friday evenings while the 25th was a Sunday and the 31st was a Saturday.

From the 9th December until the 18th March a total of 92 incidents were documented in the CCTV operator's log. A copy of this log has been produced as exhibit DJ1. DJ refers to the initials for the CCTV operator (David Johnson) tasked with undertaking this work. The dates and incidents within this CCTV log were then compared to actual times and dates against our Forces Police Incident reporting system.

Within the figure of 92 incidents 28 can be <u>directly linked</u> to Ciro's club. This amounts to 30.4% of the total number of incidents documented by CCTV operators. Almost all of those logged entries are attributed to this club and represent matters involving disorderly behaviour, collapse, drunkenness or assault which clearly do not support the primary licensing objectives. Only x9 of these documented CCTV log book entries correlated with actual Police reports against our Forces incident management system (STORM).

Delving further into this data a figure of x9 recorded incidents in 92 documented logs reports amounts to 9.7% of the total number of incidents actually reported to Police during this period.

This indicates that over 90% of incidents actually viewed by CCTV operators go unreported to the Police.

Under the list of CCTV log entries and at very end of this report are details of these log entries that correlate to reported incidents we have on our systems.

I also found that there were a further x17 incidents reported to Police (marked in Blue) at the end of this report that police dealt with during the same time frame. These reported incidents do not appear in the CCTV Log produced by this operator. These blue incidents relate to those managed by Police and are additional to those actually documented by the CCTV operator.

It is worth noting that Market Street is only one road of several within the Cumulative Impact area which also covers, North Street, South Street, Bath Street, Derby Road and the associated alley ways off Market Street.

It is obviously apparent that there appears to be a significantly higher number of incidents involving Crime and Disorder, Public safety and Nuisance occurring within the cumulative impact area in Ashby that are not actually being reported to the Police and over 30% of those documented are directly linked to Ciros nightclub.



One representation had been withdrawn. There was one letter in support of the application. Representations were from residents, businesses, Local organisations and on behalf of the Lewis Charlton residential school in the vicinity.

The representations made and confirmed at the hearing were with concerns of:

public nuisance - an increase in capacity, increase in hours, and change in format of the premises would result in a change of character to a substantial nightclub venue and this would lead to increased noise from clients drinking and smoking outside, arriving and departing from the premises and car parking and the noise breakout and impact had not been properly assessed; the noise survey by the Applicant was based on flawed methodology and there should be a new noise survey; the venue was in a residential area and would be an unacceptable impact on residents;

crime and disorder - the venue would attract substantial additional clients and this would exacerbate petty crime and disorder in the vicinity; there was an ongoing problem of late night crime and disorder, public nuisance and violence in the town centre and the venue was in a saturation policy with a presumption that the variation application should not be granted; Police manning levels could not cope with the increased anti-social behaviour; public areas in the vicinity are used by young adults and children for drinking parties and property has been subject to significant vandalism, an additional off sales outlet was not needed and the location of this new off sales venue would further aggravate the problem because it was near to public areas which already had a problem and further disturbances may result in these areas.

Promotion of Public Safety

A large increase in capacity was proposed, but the figures did not add up, the capacity figures were confusing, the existing bar, toilet and other facilities could not cope and there were no planned additional emergency exits which would be necessary to cope with the increased capacity - the current variation application did not reflect these necessary changes to the structure of the premises. There should be a Fire Authority audit,

The Protection of Children from Harm

Children who attended the residential Lewis Charlton School, a special school, were secondary school age and were especially vulnerable to the anti-social behaviour and crime and disorder which may result from the operation of the premises as a nightclub into the early hours.

At the hearing other concerns were raised, namely that the alterations to the premises were unauthorised and should have planning permission and building regulation approval, the premises license plans were inadequate, that writing on the Premises Licence plan effectively restricted the

licensable activities to indoors only, that works of alteration to the premises had taken place without the necessary Licensing Act consents, and there was no assurance that the premises could safely hold the capacity applied for without works being done.

The following amendments to the application and / or conditions were offered during the course of the hearing:

- 1. No bottles or glasses will be permitted onto Market Street, North Street, or any other public place.
- 2. The Premises Licence Holder will comply with the Dispersal Policy details of which had been circulated to the interested parties who attended the hearing and the provisions would be included as conditions on the licence as appropriate.

- 7. "Accoustic lobbies" would be installed internally to all outside doors.
- 8. During regulated entertainment regular noise patrols will be conducted by staff to ensure acceptable noise levels are not exceeded.
- 9. A noise limiter shall be installed in conjunction with recommendations from the Environmental Health Department.
- 10. Customers using the Family Room and / or Billiard Room will enter and exit the premises solely from Market Street except in emergencies.
- 11. The first floor outside terraced area would be cleared of patrons at midnight.
- 12. The Function Room was currently licensed for live and recorded music and performance of dance, late night refreshment, and the supply of alcohol until 1.00am on a Friday and Saturday evening and the application had been to extend this until 2.00am. The premises fell within the area covered by the special policy of cumulative impact in the Council's statement of Licensing Policy, which was engaged by a material variation of the Premises Licence. This application was a material variation.

2. Full text of unanimous decision on the application

To grant the application as amended by the Applicant and with the conditions referred to above, with the addition of the condition proposed by the Police re the installation of CCTV; the precise wording of the conditions was delegated to the Director of Environment.

3. Reasons for Decision

The Panel had regard to the Licensing Act 2003, the guidance from the Secretary of State, and its own Statement of Licensing Policy. It took account of the representations received in writing and made at the hearing; the variation to the application and the controls offered by the Applicant and suggested by the Police, and the submissions made.

The premises fell within the area covered by the special policy of cumulative impact in the Council's statement of Licensing Policy. The effect of adopting the special policy was to create a rebuttable presumption that a material variation of the Premises Licence would not be granted unless it can be shown there will be no negative cumulative impact on one or more of the licensing objectives.

The Panel recognised the concerns of the objectors relating to Public Safety, in the form of health and safety concerns including fire safety and capacity, but considered the controls offered and also as there where no objections from Responsible Authorities, and such matters could also be controlled through separate statutory controls or self regulation and not be duplicated as LA 2003 controls (in accordance with the Statutory guidance.) So the Panel considered no further controls where necessary and the grant of the application would not undermine the licensing objective.

There was no evidence that Controls offered the Protection of Children objective would be harmed by the grant of the Application.

The Panel accepted that the plans and the other information supplied were sufficient for them to determine the application, and the writing on the existing Premises Licence plan did not constitute conditions or any other restrictions on the operation of the licensed premises as there was no evidence they formed part of previous licensing applications and were not duplicated elsewhere as restrictions on the previous and existing Premises Licence. The alleged unauthorised development at the premises could be controlled through Planning and Building Regulation enforcement and any physical alterations to the Premises could, as confirmed by the Licensing Officer, be dealt with through the new minor variations procedure, and so these in itself were not reasons to refuse the application.

The Panel noted there was no evidence that directly linked the premises or the adjoining premises owned by the Applicant directly to problems with crime and disorder, public nuisance, The protection of Children from harm and noted that the Police had withdrawn their representation subject to the CCTV condition.

The Panel recognised there were concerns of noise nuisance to nearby residents, but noted there were no objections by the Council's Environmental Protection Team on noise nuisance grounds, noted the controls proposed, and accepted the evidence of the Applicant's noise expert. The Panel accepted that other premises in Market Street were open beyond 1.00am, and that the premises already enjoyed a licence until that time.

The Panel were satisfied that, on the balance of probability and having regard to the evidence provided, the lack of any substantive objections from responsible authorities, the controls offered by the Applicant and their proposed methods of management of the premises, that there would not be a negative effect on the cumulative impact by granting the Application. The Panel reminded the Applicant that they would take a serious view of any problems with drugs being associated with the premises and urged the Applicant to formalise any changes that are necessary to the physical fabric of the premises with a variation application and ensure early compliance with all Planning and Building Regulation controls.
