OUTCOMES OF THE PLANNING PEER CHALLENGE

REPLACEMENT OF PARAGRAPH 3.3 IN THE MAIN BODY OF THE REPORT AS FOLLOWS

‘It is proposed that a cross party member/officer working group is established to oversee the development and implementation of the action plan arising from the Peer Challenge recommendations. The member representation on the working group will comprise the portfolio holder for Planning, three members from the majority group, two members from the labour group and one member from the liberal democrat/ independent groups. External support and best practice advice will be provided through the Planning Advisory Service who will be engaged to support the working group. The group would have no delegated powers as implementation of the action plan would be via the existing scheme of delegation.

It is proposed to hold the first meeting of the working group before the end of March where the terms of reference for the group will be agreed.
