Surely the manager must have some duty to ensure that his clients keep quiet since he is the one providing them with the alcohol.</p> <p>Can you confirm what, if anything, that the council is doing to curb this noise and all the other problems listed in previous e-mails.</p> <p>2) <u>27 August 2013</u></p> <p>Friday/Saturday 23rd /24th August relatively low noise levels.</p> <p>Saturday/Sunday 24th/25th August very noisy between 1:15 a.m. and 2:00 am with people leaving the 3 Crowns</p>

Monday 26th the pub held a beer festival with outside bar and B-B-Q. Very noisy with music being played outside via speaker around 4:00 p.m.

Cannot confirm if this was the speaker that they had supposedly disconnected or another one. (if they say the speaker has been disconnected why don't they remove it ?)

Noise levels relatively low through the rest of the evening and music had ceased. Only noise was from drinkers in the beer garden.

I also note that apart from the Bunting attached the railings outside the 3 Crowns a new advertising sign has been erected against the railings. As this is only leaning against the railings, I suppose technically they have not attached it to the railings. Tuesday 26th August - several empty plastic beer glasses littering the street and pathways

3) 8-9 March 2014

Once again have to contact you regarding the noise from the above establishment. It was hoped that after several weeks of relative quiet the noise has kicked off again. Two weeks ago our neighbour was forced to contact the police over the noise and this weekend (Saturday night) my wife telephoned the police over the row which persisted from about 11 :30 p.m. to 1 :30 a.m.

The police contacted us on Sunday to say they would visit us to discuss the problem. It would appear that the pub has still not listened to yourselves regarding noise

4) 12-13 April 2014

Once again we had to resort to calling the police on Saturday night /Sunday morning as the racket went on from 12 midnight until 1:30 a.m. This was then followed by drunken and shouting in the street until about 2:30 a.m. No doubt you will be hearing from my neighbour [REDACTED], who also called the police

5) 28 April 2014

Please accept this letter as my representation over the licence at The Three Crowns Public House, 25 Market Place, Whitwick.

I have been subject to intolerable behaviour from this establishment for well over two years now and despite warnings from relevant associated bodies, this public house seems unable to keep its house in order.

The situation is intolerable and unbearable as I (and local residents) are subject to anti-social behaviour, shouting, yelling, extremely loud music, fighting (inside & outside the public house) prompting on many occasions police response and unless something is done then the situation will escalate out of control.

Quite simply, I am at the whim and wish of this public house as to whether I will sleep or not sleep and whether I will be subject to such anti-social behaviour that life particularly at weekends is unbearable and frightening.

You cannot turn a local pub in a residential area into a night club / night spot and the relevant bodies involved have a 'duty of care to me and others to protect us from troublesome, anti-social behaviour that has become the norm.

Posters displayed in the pub windows advertise Saturday late night evening events as 'Whitwick Rocks' ~ Enough said I feel.

I have dates, letters of reported incidents from Leicestershire Police to support my representation and I am prepared to attend the committee meeting when the licence is reviewed to make my representation, if required.


Quite simply, enough is enough and the running of this pub is not in keeping with the community and in fact I believe that those running this establishment do not care at all about the effect on the local community.

My life at weekends in particular has and will continue to be 'hell on earth' unless those with the powers to change things acts forcibly and with immediate effect.
