# Ashby Ivanhoe Football Club

## Application for Variations to their Premises Licence

As a neighbour of Ashby Ivanhoe Football Club you may be interested to know that the club is applying for variations to its existing premises licence. (see overleaf)

### Current license conditions:

1. Recorded music permitted: Monday – Friday between 09:00 – 12:00hrs and 18:00 – 22:00hrs. Sat & Sun between 18:00 – 22:00hrs.
2. Facilities for Dancing: Recorded music permitted as in 1 above.
3. Sale of Alcohol: Monday – Sunday 12:00 – 22:00hrs.
4. Hours premises open to the public: Monday – Sunday 09:00 – 22:00hrs
5. No open containers of alcohol are permitted outside of the designated area being an area extending no more than six metres from the building line at the front of the premises to be clearly marked in a conspicuous manner.
6. No amplified music to be played outside the building.
7. The number of casual hiring's for private functions will be no more than 50 such events in a twelve month period.

### The Club is applying for:

- The extension of the sale by retail of alcohol (including the addition of “off premises” sales) from 10:00am to midnight and the extension of recorded music from 12:00 – 23:00hrs.
- The addition of live music inside and outside the premises from 12:00 to 23:00hrs.
- The removal of restrictions with regard to the playing of live/amplified/recorded music and the removal of restrictions concerning pre-booked private functions.

The current conditions were imposed in recognition of the proximity of the club to local residents and to promote the licensing objectives which are:

- The prevention of crime and disorder.
- The prevention of public nuisance.
- Public safety.
- The protection of children from harm.

You may wish to consider the potential effect on the quality of life of neighbours in the near vicinity of the club should these variations be granted.
