<b>To prevent crime and disorder</b>	We live a quarter of a mile from the football ground and even before these things are changed there are problems with people attending the football club, driving across the pavement to park on the grass on the other side of the road to the football club on match days. When people leave the football club and turn left cars speed around the two corners on a very narrow road. There is currently a car in the hedge with police tape around it. We have concerns with the club being on the outskirts of Ashby and not walking distance of some people who live in Ashby that it may result in some people drinking and driving. Due to the nature of the entrance to the football club cars leaving are forced to drive partially over the road to see if traffic is coming from the left or the right and could result in an oncoming vehicle potentially mounting the curb and possibly hitting a pedestrian.

<p><b>To prevent public nuisance</b></p>	<p>Live/amplified/recorded music both inside and outside will result in noise pollution. I work weekends and go to bed between 8.30 and 9.00pm due to getting up at 4.30am. This would result in sleep deprivation. I drive a petrol tanker for a living.</p> <p>When they have an out door concert at Cattows Farm in Heather we can clearly hear the music from Western Close so we are fearful that the potential of loud music at the football club would prevent me from sleeping and would prevent me from being able to attend work the following day due to the nature of my job and my contract.</p> <p>There will also be increased night time traffic on a very narrow road. Unsocial behaviour of people leaving the premises after potentially drinking for a long period of time not forgetting the lack of light if turning left out of the football club and the path being extremely narrow in places when walking up the hill towards Avenue Road.</p>
