Users and staff alike have no respect for local residents. You never know what will be happening at the weekends. I am on medication for anxiety and depression and the issues with the Bistro are making it worse; I don't like going out the front of my house because of the issues the bistro has caused making me feel uncomfotable and anxious.

To prevent crime and disorder	People are outside late at night, drunk, shouting and generally very noisy. This is unfair to the local residents who are trying to sleep; some are elderly and frightened of what is happening. How do we know that these people are not going to damage property, cause an accident on the junction by distracting drivers passing by?
Public safety	Cars and delivery lorries pulling up on to the pavement on Ashby Road. Some of the cars are there for a considerably long time. This makes it very difficult, sometimes impossible and unsafe for people either trying to cross the road or to walk along the footpath. The lorries also obstruct the view for vehicles pulling out of Rawdon Road. They turn round in the road near the island, making it a possibility for an accident. There is a large carpark at the back of the building!?
To prevent public nuisance	Ouside speakers have been used and the music has been so loud we could hear it in our house and in our garden which is approximately100 metres from Eden Bistro. We are unable to enjoy our own home and garden because of the Bistro. The music can go on late into the night and has also been on early Sunday mornings. The people that are visiting the Bistro are very loud at night and so are taxis/ cars that arrive to pick them up. So much so that we are unable to sleep. This type of establishment should be in a town or city, not a residential area in a village. Delivery lorries turn up at the front of the bistro in the early hours
