- 1) WE HAVE TRADED SINCE 2014 TO DATE
- 2) WE HAVE BEEN AWARDED CAMRA BEST PUB AND BEEN 9 YEARS OUT OF TEN INCLUDING 2024. 4000 PUBS SELECTED NATIONALLY OUT OF 60,000 PUBS IN THE COUNTRY
- 3) FROM 2014 AND THROUGH COVID CHAIRS HAVE BEEN OUTSIDE ACTIVELY ENCOURAGED BY THE GOVERNMENT
- 4) LEICESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL REJECTS ALL APPLICATIONS FOR SEATING DUE TO ACCESS ISSUES WHICH I FEEL IS UNJUST
- 5) WE ARE REAPPLYING THROUGH NW LEICESTERSHIRE FOR SEATING
- 6) WE WERE AWARDED A CERTIFICATE FOR SERVICES TO THE COMMUNITY THROUGHOUT COVID. SUPPLYING UP TO 25/30 MEALS A DAY (AT OUR COST). DELIVERED TO SINGLE PEOPLE, THE ELDERLY, SICK PEOPLE AND THE VULNERABLE.
- 7) WE FEEL VICTIMISED AGAINST OTHER BOLTONSHIRE BUSINESSES BREAKING THE PAVEMENT DISTANCING RULES
- 8) WE ARE NERVOUS RE SUBMITTING A FURTHER APPLICATION BUT ENCOURAGED BY PAUL DENNIS TO DO SO

REGARDING THE FOLLOWING

1) THE PREVENTION OF CRIME & DISORDER

I HAVE ALWAYS POLICED ANY POTENTIAL ISSUES IN THIS AREA.

NOTIFIED NW LEICESTERSHIRE & POLICE IF NECESSARY AND WORKED WITH OTHER LICENCES IN THE TOWN

2) PUBLIC SAFETY

THERE HAS NEVER BEEN ANY SERIOUS ISSUES INVOLVING THE FLAG IN THIS AREA.

PEOPLE ARE ASKED TO LEAVE QUICKLY AND QUIETLY WITHIN THE LICENCING HOURS SIGNS ARE IN PLACE AND VERBALLY TOLD

3) PREVENTION OF PUBLIC NUISANCE

I HAVE INTERVENED IF NECESSARY AND TAKEN APPROPRIATE ACTION

I HAVE POLICED THE PAVEMENT TO PROTECT NEIGHBOURS i.e. using window ledges and doorsteps as dunkey areas.

A) PROTECTION OF CHILDREN FROM HARM

CHILDREN ARE ONLY ALLOWED IN THE MICROBUS WHEN ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT. NOT SERVED ALCOHOL AND ASKED TO LEAVE BY 8.P.M.

CHILDREN ARE ALLOWED TO USE THE TOILET WHEN ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT DURING ANY STREET EVENTS

5) REGARDING SEATING.

DURING COVID THE GOVERNMENT ENCOURAGED OUTSIDE SEATING

I BELIEVE THE NW LEICESTERSHIRE TEAM WERE NOT AWARE OF LEICESTERSHIRE CC REJECTING ANY APPLICATIONS DUE TO ACCESS BANK INSUFFICIENT.

THE ARIARY NEXT DOOR HAS PERMISSION WITH MINIMAL DISTANCING DIFFERENCES TO THE FLAG. ALSO LEICESTERSHIRE HIGHWAY CONTRAVENING THE DISTANCING ISSUES BY PLACING SIGNPOSTS IN THE MIDDLE OF THE PAVEMENT. BREAKING THEIR OWN REGULATIONS.

6) CCTV

I ACCEPT THERE HAVE BEEN ISSUES WITH CCTV REQUESTS. THIS HAS BEEN DOWN TO MY TECHNICAL ABILITY AND ERROR IN MANAGING THE SYSTEM.
