In which I have applied for a premise licence for the sale of alcohol and late night refreshment it is not to attempt to solely become a Bar or nightclub but rather be able to offer an alcoholic beverage to customers when dining with us.

CONCERN #1 TO PREVENT CRIME & DISORDER

Representation made -

As evening access to the premises, which are attached to the back of the Town Hall building, is along a small, isolated alley that connects South Street to Market Street, there is concern that this area will not have sufficient security and the presence of licensed premises, with outside drinking permitted on a terrace area, is likely to increase crime in the area. The applicant states that door security staff will only be provided, "when i deem necessary". This is wholly inadequate as security will rely upon the subjective judgement of the licensee.

We would draw attention the fact that the application premises lie at the centre of the Ashby Cumulative Impact Zone (CIZ), where "the number of premises licences and club premises certificates are such that it is likely that granting further licences or variations to existing premises licences and/or club premises certificates would be inconsistent with our duty to promote the licensing objectives". The CIZ was reviewed and renewed very recently (February 2022) with full police backing.

ADRESS #1 PREVENTION OF CRIME & DISORDER

'I would like to being addressing the quote from my application where it was quoted to have supposedly mentioned "where i deem necessary" in regards to door supervision.

This is incorrect and gives a false impression of how I the licensee intend to implement and uphold safe licensing objectives.

The true representation of what was mentioned on the licence application stated;

"I will use or employ door supervisors <u>at all times when a licensable activity is carried out</u> and i consider them necessary to:


1.Prevent the admission and ensure the departure from the premises of drunk and disorderly persons, without causing further disorder.

2.Keep out excluded individuals (subject to court or pub watch bans).

3.Search and exclude persons suspected of carrying illegal drugs or offensive weapons.".

Further more, suggesting an increase of Crime and disorder in the area due to an exterior terrace in which only 15 person(s) can consume food and drink at one time, I find rather inadequate and rather choosy given our neighbour Lounges uk limited, has been granted approval for consumption of alcohol & late night refreshment, inside their premise and externally on the high street / rear garden everyday, between the hours of 10:00am - 12:30am.

Therefore I struggle to find reasoning as to why CIZ has been mentioned (please find map of CIZ attached), When other recent applicants within the CIZ area have had no concern with regards to their application.'

CONCERN #2 PUBLIC SAFETY

Representations made -

The courtyard access to the premises is shared by a taxi firm with poorly defined discrimination between pedestrians and vehicles. Currently taxi vehicles have to reverse in or out of their parking spaces which is likely to lead to collisions with pedestrians accessing and leaving the licensed premises.

I would also like to add that we care about and work closely with our neighbours Abbey Taxi's, La Spezia Pizzeria, Motiv 8 Gym, The Market Stall Holders & Meraki to ensure no hinderance to either parties in regards to operating our business's and all agree on decisions in regards to safe use of the courtyard.

Customers can also enter the premise via the town hall market but is limited to between the hours of 10:00am - 16:00pm at which point the Town Hall Market will close and access will have to be gained via Bakery Court."

Representations made -

There is currently just one takeaway establishment on Bakery Court, meaning customers arrive and depart relatively quickly. This application is a restaurant and is proposing both indoor and outdoor seating meaning a significant increase in noise in the area from customers dining in and outside the establishment. The noise is likely to be heard by inhabitants of town centre dwellings, particularly premises that back on to, and are situated, on South Street (South Street consisting of predominantly residential dwellings).

ADDRESS #3 NOISE AND NUISANCE TO NEAR BY RESIDENTS


"Regarding Noise and nuisance, The business has currently been operating for around 6 weeks, and yet to receive any formal complaint with regards to noise levels or disturbances to near by residence or other.

During this 6 weeks period we have had customers both inside and on the exterior terrace with amplified music played from the hours of 17:00pm - 22:30pm (Current Business Operating Schedule). 0 complaints.

We are also surrounded by multiple Nightclubs and Pubs (please refer to detailed map below) that ONLY offer Alcohol & live / pre recorded music at levels which can be heard from the majority of residence in the town.

That being said I find it somewhat hard to believe that it has been suggested that our small Food Establishment will cause disturbance to the local residence, in comparison to the already heard & soon to be heard licensed business's existing in the town's centre.

I have also gone out and personally spoke to residents along south street in regards to your concerns and not one resident can confirm of any disturbance from our premise in comparison to those already operating. In particular The Lamb Inn, Ciro's, Manhattan's nightclub

Representations made -

There is a gym/boxing club situated on Bakery Court directly next door to these premises that provides exercise and training for children of all ages, many of whom gather outside the gym, beside the application premises outside balcony, before and after their training sessions. The Committee is concerned that children using gym will be subject to inappropriate comments & language from intoxicated customers of XXX Buns Ltd with the possibility of more severe harm.

ADDRESS #4 PREVENTION OF HARM AGAINST CHILDREN

"Although it is the licensee's duties to ensure the safety of public and protection for children against harm it is not the licensee's responsibility to supervise another business's attendee's and therefore down to the gym owner to provide a safe space(s) for children to be picked up / dropped off from by parents in regards to the children classes mentioned. Wether before or after their training sessions it is also down to the gym owner to ensure that no child / attendee loiters outside or uses another business terrace as a 'climbing frame' or 'chill spot' out of respect for their neighbours and ensure they are collected by a parent/guardian accordingly.

That being said, it has been agreed upon by the gym owner himself and I, that he has no concern or objections regarding our application for a new premise licence.

This is simply down to, we plan to operate at times when the children's classes do not. (Please see current operating times below in red).

The idea that children will be exposed to any/more illicit material wether verbal or physical and more severe harm is groundless and can be applied or said to every and all pubs/restaurants that provision the sale of alcohol."
