QUESTION AND ANSWER SESSION

Question from Mr C Taylor

'Full council voted 35 to 1 for the petition to remove WWV from the plan being referred to LPC, because WWV site doesn't meet any of the plan objectives, isn't in line with proposed planning reforms and fails to treat WWV fairly in terms of creating an area of separation. Councillor Legry proposed that no more sites should be removed which were recommended by Officers. Does this mean that no sites will be removed from the plan until the appeal stage, whether or not they are viable?'

Response from the Chair of the Local Plan Committee

'The decision as to whether any site should be excluded (or included) in the final Local Plan will, in the first instance, be for members of the Local Plan Committee to decide having regard to evidence, including, not limited to, the ongoing transport modelling and the viability assessment. The final decision as to the content of the Local Plan will rest with a meeting of the full Council.'
