Noise and Traffic Disturbance  The introduction of a delivery-based operation will inevitably increase vehicle traffic to and from the property, particularly during evenings and weekends when residents expect peace and quiet. The presence of delivery drivers and customers will result in increased noise from engines, doors slamming, and conversations, all of which are inconsistent with the expectations of a residential setting. This is especially concerning given the narrow and otherwise low-traffic nature of the surrounding streets.
To prevent public nuisance	2. Inappropriate Use of Residential Property  The operation of a commercial business selling alcohol by way of delivery service is fundamentally incompatible with the intended residential use of the area. It sets a concerning precedent for the commercialisation of private homes, potentially leading to a deterioration of the quiet, residential character of the neighbourhood.
