Noise and Traffic Disturbance</p> <p>The introduction of a delivery-based operation will almost certainly increase the traffic flow down a narrow quiet residential road that has only just quietened down following the completion of the new build houses. What has now turned into a “normal” flow of neighbouring traffic will be disrupted once again with the comings and goings of deliveries to and from the business</p>
To prevent public nuisance	<p>2. Inappropriate Use of Residential Property</p> <p>The operation of a commercial business selling alcohol by way of delivery service is fundamentally incompatible with the intended residential use of the area. The hours which the business intends to open are the times when families relax over the weekend and do not want to hear the noise from a business selling alcohol in a quiet residential street.</p>
