

FORMER TAXI DRIVER CONVICTED AFTER NEW EVIDENCE EMERGES

DNA EVIDENCE TRAPS RAPIST TWO DECADES AFTER ATTACK ON A STUDENT

DNA evidence has led to the conviction of a rapist who attacked a student nearly two decades ago.

Mahbubur Rahman, then 31, who was working as a taxi driver, picked up a 19-year-old Loughborough University student shortly after 2.15am on October 7, 2006.

He is believed to have driven the woman to George Deacon Court car park, in Chestnut Street, where he raped her.

DNA evidence was recovered but did not match the profile of anyone on the police database at the time and in 2009, the case was filed.

In April 2022, Rahman was arrested on suspicion of burglary, and DNA from a mouth swab taken matched samples recovered at the time of the rape.

Rahman, of Jane Street,
Chadderton, Greater Manchester, denied the charge
but was convicted at a trial
this week. He will be sentenced at a later date.


